2019-20 Dance Season at Casa Dance!

Hello and Welcome to Casa Dance Studio!

It's time to register for the 2019-20 Dance Season. We are expecting to have a packed Fall schedule, so whether you are a returning family or new to Casa Dance we are looking forward to seeing you in September!

Please read all of the info below and then send in your registration! You may register online, by mail or in person.

Classes are assigned by age first but may be adjusted once you attend class. Purple, Turquoise, Coral, Red, Gray, and Black levels are by audition and teacher recommendation only.

Classes & Events will begin Monday Sept 9, 2019 and will continue through June 2020.

You have a GRAY LEVEL dancer.

This level is for dancers 9 years old or older. Gray level is for dancers who show a strong interest in increasing dance & acro skills and have met the skill requirements. Dancers in Gray level must take Level 4 or higher acro, Ballet, Lyrical, & Jazz choreography classes, 1 Ballet Technique class, one conditioning class, and one Jumps & Turns class. Dancers have the opportunity to take Tap, Hip Hop, Modern/Contemporary, Pre Pointe, Pointe, additional Technique classes, and/or Polynesian.

Gray Level Requirements:

Dancers in this level are required to take Level 4 or higher Acro, Ballet, Lyrical, & Jazz choreography classes, 1 Ballet Technique class, a conditioning class, and a Jumps & Turns class. Dancers in this level must attend class regularly. They cannot miss any more than one class a month unless they have a doctor's note and may be required to take private lessons to make up technique/choreography work. If injured, dancers must still attend their choreography classes, watch, and take notes. Dancers that miss dance for any reason may be required to take private lessons to catch up or make up required class time. These lessons are \$38 per half hour.

Competition: Dancers in this level are required to attend one local competition, Royal Dance Competition & World Class Talent Experience with two group dances at each competition, and Elevate Dance Convention. Dancers may not take Vacations during competition season (February-May) except on designated closure dates.

Ways to register:

- Come to the studio and register and pay the non-refundable members fee in person.
- Call us at 856-845-5788 to register by phone then bring cash, check, credit/debit card payment to the studio. Please note that until the non-refundable members fee is paid your registration is not complete.

As of Aug 18^{th,} you may pick your classes and pay online or look at the schedule and email us the classes you want and pay in the studio or just come in to the studio and do it all at the same time. Please remember you will not be enrolled in a class until you pay the members fee. September class fees are due your first class or before. Dancers may not start classes until the Acknowledgement Form, the Payment Agreement Form, and the Release Forms are all signed.

DRESS CODE

Dancers in Gray Level have a dress code. Gray level dancers must wear a black leotard in any style or black Crop Tops or form fitting Camisoles/Tank tops with solid Gray shorts or Gray leggings -no leggings may be worn in Ballet classes. Dancers must wear pink or tan convertible or stirrup tights. Male dancers must wear black dance shirt with gray shorts or dance pants. Dancers must have their hair secured back.. The first week of every month dancers may do Freestyle Fashion week. Dancers may wear any color they dance outfit they wish but may not wear BLACK CHERRY dance shorts at any time.

DRESS CODE applies to ALL classes.

PERFORMANCE OPPORTUNITIES

At Casa Dance we encourage everyone to perform. All of our classes (except technique only classes) learn routines to perform in shows throughout the year, in the Holiday Family Shows, and in the end of season Recital. We start our students out with holiday performances in December at local nursing homes and benefit shows. Mark your calendars for November 30, December 7, 14 December 7, 14 & 21! We do more nursing home and community shows in the spring with the recital dances and then the big Recital. We have 4-5 separate shows over a weekend in June. Dancers in multiple dances may be in more than one show. We do try to limit the number of shows each dancer is in. While tickets do have to be purchased by parents, family members, and/or friends to see the recital, the student does not have to buy a ticket.

RECITAL

We will be having our recitals over a weekend in June TBD. Recital Date will be out by October. Information on the show in which your dancer will be performing will be available by the end of March. We will be holding a Front/Second Row Raffle to benefit our Scholarship Fund during April. On April 30th winners will be announced and will be able to pick their seats for their family members. On May 5th our ticket sales will go live. You will be sent a link so you can pick your seats. All dancers are required to pay a \$55 Recital Fee which includes a digital video download of Recital, digital access to ALL of your dancer's photos (taken by two different photographers), dancer's entrance to ALL recital shows, ability for parents to take their own photos and videos (from their seat, cameras at eye level), the limited edition recital t-shirt, digital access to the recital program and access to flash sale ticket prices. Ask about our premium recital package bundle for additional discounts and recital items.

PAYMENTS

To enroll with Casa Dance Studio, you must pay the non-refundable members fee to secure your dancer's spot in his/her class and to ensure your rates throughout the 2019-20 dance season.

ALL families must have a current <u>credi</u>t card that expires <u>after</u> July 2020 on file in their Studio Online Account, debit cards will not be accepted as the main card on your account without a signed consent. Payments are due the first week of each month and are considered on time if paid by the 10th of every month. We accept cash, money orders or checks. Debit/Credit card payments are available in the studio or online through your account or through PayPal. You may also set up automatic payment through your studio online account with us. Automatic payments are to be applied to credit cards only, debit cards are not acceptable for our Automatic Payment Program. Automatic payments will be done by the 11th of every month.

Any payments not received by the 10^{th} of the month will be automatically charged to your credit card on file by the 11^{th} . Any accounts with credit cards that are declined or out of date will receive late fees and returned card processing fees if your balance is not paid by 8pm on the 11^{th} . *

CLASS FEES

Class Fees are based on a total for the season.

Payments are due by the 10th of each month September thru May depending on your payment choice. Credit cards will be run on the 11th of every month and no later than the 15th for any past due items including costumes, shoes, competition fees, etc. There is NO June payment. Dancers will receive a minimum of 35 weeks of classes/events.

You may choose to pay your SEASON fee in the below ways.

1. MONTHLY: The SEASON total is divided into NINE (9) equal monthly payments. The monthly payments are **NOT** dependent on the number of weeks in each month.

2. THREE EQUAL INSTALLMENTS: Pay 1/3 of Season cost in September, 1/3 in January, & 1/3 in March **Receive a 1% discount if paying by cash ONLY

3. PAY BI-SEASONALLY: pay 50% of total season cost in September & 50% in January*** Receive a 2% discount on your season tuition if paying by Cash ONLY

4. PAY IN FULL: Pay the entire season cost in September. ****Receive a 3% discount on your season tuition if paying by Cash ONLY

Please note that there are no refunds or pro rating for missed classes. If you miss a class, please speak with your instructor for the best time and day to make up the missed class.

We accept cash, money orders or checks. Debit/Credit card payments are available in the studio or online through your account or through PayPal using payments.casadance@gmail.com.

Gray Level Monthly Class Fees

<u>Members Fee \$40.00 per student</u> - Members Fee is non-refundable and ensures dancer's spot in class, discounted tuition rates, recital package rate, discounted dance wear, clothing, tights, shoes, costume prices, access to recital package, discounted recital tickets.

- Dancers receive 1 pair of Gray shorts, 1 pair of class tights, and one leotard upon payment of Members Fee and September's tuition.
- Gray Level dancers pay September-May for required classes. Please see below Chart for Pricing info.
- All Gray level classes, required classes, and Technique classes recommended by Teacher are included.
- Family Holiday Performances: Gray Level Dancers will be required to bring in snacks, desserts, or drinks. You will be assigned something to bring. Families will receive 2 Holiday Performance Tickets.
- Awards Banquet: Gray Level Dancers will be required to bring in an item. You will be assigned something to bring.

Gray level Costume, Competition, & Convention Payment Plan

- August \$100 competition commitment fee & first costume payment due
- September Elevate Convention Fee & second costume payment due
- October third costume payment due
- November fourth & final costume payment due
- December local competition fee & Believe competition fee due
- January Royal Dance Competition Fee due
- February World Class Dance Experience Competition Fee due
- End of March Imagine Dance Challenge Fees Due **only for dancers wishing to participate in WDC who did not receive a Golden Ticket at Believe
- June World Dance Championship Rehearsal Fee & Competition fee Due ** Only for those who received a Golden Ticket
- Costume payment plans will be estimated as \$100 for each of the two competition costumes, \$60 for each non competitive costume. These prices are estimates based on last season's prices & may have to be adjusted. We will do our best have costumes come as close or below these prices if possible

World Dance Championships

We will be attending Believe with group dances interested in going to the World Dance Championships.

Dancers interested in competing at WDC must fill out the below form acknowledging the understanding of the requirements & fees. Please understand that IF your dancer's group gets chosen for WDC it is not like a regular competition. There are dancers from all over the world and only the best at each regional is chosen. Agreeing to compete in the hopes of receiving a Golden Ticket to WDC means committing to additional summer practices that may be on weekends, being there for your team, taking the required classes, and paying the required fees on time.

Based on previous years WDC will be approximately \$75 per dancer per dance. This event is usually held the last week of July or the first week of August at the Meadowlands Exposition Center.

Dancers Interested in WDC must be available for Believe Dance Competition as well as Imagine Dance Challenge in May (dancers will only compete here if they do not receive a Golden Ticket at Believe)

Are you interested in the possibility of competing at World Dance Championships in 2020?

If yes, do you understand & accept that there is a \$30 per dancer per dance Worlds Rehearsal fee? Please note this fee is to pay your rehearsing teacher(s) for the time they give.

If yes, do you understand and accept that Worlds practices are scheduled on Friday evening & Saturday mornings in July leading up to the Championship and they are MANDATORY?**

**We will do our best to switch the rehearsal times to weekdays, but there are multiple people involved (your dancer, his/her teammates, the teachers, the studio space) and thus multiple schedules with which to contend. If weekday rehearsals cannot be scheduled your dancer will be obligated to the Friday/Saturday rehearsals. Dance parents may NOT ask other dance parents to rearrange their schedules. If any dance parent does this, that dancer's schedule will not be considered.
