***Credit cards on file will be charged the 15th of every month for tuition & costume payment plan unless payment has been received before then. Class Fees are based on a Session total NOT the number of classes in a month. There are no refunds or pro-rating for missed classes. Missed classes can be made up. If you attend more than one class there are no refunds if you do not continue. Charges will continue unless you notify CDS in writing by email or mail that you will not be returning. Charges will be stopped beginning the month after receipt of the withdrawal notification. We accept credit/debit card, PayPal, cash, check and Money orders. Participation in dance classes is at your own risk. We take pictures and video during class and events. By registering at CDS you agree to allow you or your child's photos/videos to be used for advertising purposes. If you do not want your photos/videos used please notify Casa Dance Studio by email. 2018-19 Dance Season at Casa Dance!

Hello and Welcome to Casa Dance Studio!

It's time to register for the 2018-19 Dance Season. We are expecting to have a packed Fall schedule, so whether you are a returning family or new to Casa Dance we are looking forward to seeing you in September!

Please read all of the info below and then send in your registration! You may register online, by mail or in person.

Classes are assigned by age first but may be adjusted once you attend class. Purple, Coral, Red, Gray, and Black levels are by audition and teacher recommendation only.

Classes will begin Monday Sept 10, 2018 and will continue through June 15, 2019. Recital week is June 17 to Recital Days! - June 22-23.

You have a GRAY LEVEL dancer.

This level is for dancers 10-15 years old. Dancers in this level are required to take a minimum of three Ballet Technique only classes, one Acro class, one Jazz class, and one Pre-Pointe class. Dancers are encouraged to take as many Ballet Technique classes as possible. Dancers in this level may take any style of dance we offer EXCEPT Belly Dance.

Gray dancers are highly competitive dancers. They generally take 3 group dances to each competition.

Gray Level Requirements:

Dancers in this level are required to take minimum of three Ballet Technique only classes, one Acro class, one Jazz class, and one Pre-Pointe class. Dancers are strongly encouraged to take as many Ballet Technique only classes as possible. Dancers in this level are required to compete three group dances in three competitions. TEACHERS, not parents, choose the group dances to compete. Dancers in this level must attend class regularly. They cannot miss anymore than one class a month unless they have a doctor's note. If injured, dancers must still attend their choreography classes, watch and take notes. Dancers may not take Vacations during competition season (February-May) except on designated closure dates. Any injured dancer who chooses not to attend class to watch will be required to arrange private classes with their teacher at \$30 per half hour. Dancers must have a minimum of 10 hours of Ballet Technique a month. This does not include your Ballet class in which you learn a dance. If they miss for any reason they must come to additional technique classes to make up the time. Dancers that miss dance due to other activities may speak to their teacher about private lessons to make up class time. These lessons are \$30 per half hour.

- Call us at 856-845-5788 to register by phone then bring cash, check, credit/debit card payment to the studio. Please note that until the non-refundable members fee is paid your registration is not complete.

As of Aug 18th, you may pick your classes and pay online or look at the schedule and email us the classes you want and pay in the studio or just come in to the studio and do it all at the same time. Please remember you will not be enrolled in a class until you pay the members fee. September class fees are due your first class or before. Dancers may not start classes until the Acknowledgement Form, the Payment Agreement Form, and the Release Forms are all signed.

DRESS CODE

Dancers in Gray Level have a dress code. Gray level dancers must wear a black leotard in any style with solid Gray shorts. Dancers must wear pink or tan convertible or stirrup tights. Male dancers must wear black dance shirt with gray shorts or dance pants. Dancers must have their hair secured back. Dancers may wear black Crop Tops or form fitting Camisoles/Tank tops. The first week of every month dancers may do Freestyle Fashion week. Dancers may wear any color they dance outfit they wish but may not wear BLACK CHERRY dance shorts at any time.

DRESS CODE applies to ALL classes.

PERFORMANCE OPPORTUNITIES

At Casa Dance we encourage everyone to perform. All of our classes (except technique only classes) learn routines to perform in shows throughout the year, in the Holiday Family Shows, and in the end of season Recital. We start our students out with holiday performances in December at local nursing homes and benefit shows. Mark your calendars for December 1, 8 & 15! We do more nursing home and community shows in the spring with the recital dances and then the big Recital. We have 4-5 separate shows on the last weekend in June. Gray Level dancers will be in multiple shows. While tickets do have to be purchased by parents, family members, and/or friends to see the recital, the student does not have to buy a ticket.

RECITAL

On June 22-23, 2019 we will have our recitals. Please mark these days in your calendar. Information on which show you will be performing in will be available by the end of March. All dancers are required to pay a \$35 Recital Fee which includes a digital video download of Recital, dancer's entrance to ALL recital shows, ability for parents to take their own photos and videos. Gray level dancers participating in the Recital may choose to purchase the Recital Package (\$199 minimum value). Included in the package will be the Recital Fee, two Tickets to the show in which your dancer is performing (dancers are free), access to discounted recital & awards tickets, a Recital T-Shirt, Recital Program Best Wishes Patron Ad, 2 Recital Programs, 2 Awards Tickets (dancers are free), digital copy of all action shots of your dancer dancing, and either a bouquet of roses or a recital bear. You will be able to add additional T-Shirts, Awards Tickets, Recital Tickets, roses, or bears at an additional cost. The Recital Package payment is due by April 1st. The package is \$140. You may pay in installments throughout the year or in full anytime by April 1st.

PAYMENTS

To enroll with Casa Dance Studio, you must pay the non-refundable members fee to secure your dancer's spot in his/her class and to ensure your rates throughout the 2018-19 dance season.

ALL families must have a current **credit** card that expires **after** July 2019 on file in their Studio Online Account, debit cards will not be accepted as the main card on your account. Payments are due the first week of class and are considered on time if paid by the 10th of every month. We accept cash, money orders or checks. Debit/Credit card payments are available in the studio or online through your account or through PayPal using payments.casadance@gmail.com. You may also set up automatic payment through your studio online account with us. Automatic payments are to be applied to credit cards only, debit cards are not acceptable for our Automatic Payment Program. Automatic payments will be done by the 15th of every month.

Any payments not received by the 10th of the month will be automatically charged to your credit card on file on the 15th. Any accounts with credit cards that are declined or out of date will receive late fees and returned card processing fees if your balance is not paid by the 15th.

CLASS FEES

Class Fees are based on a **total for the season**. This total is divided into TEN (10) equal monthly payments. The monthly payments are **NOT** dependent on the number of weeks in each month. You may choose to pay monthly, semi-seasonally** (Pay 50% in September & 50% in February), or once seasonally*** (pay 100% in September). By choosing to pay your tuition Semi-Seasonally or once Seasonally you will be qualified to receive discounts. See below for more details. We also have an All-Inclusive Tuition option. There are no refunds or pro rating for missed classes. If you miss a class, please speak with your instructor for the best time and day to make up the missed class.

We accept cash, money orders or checks. Debit/Credit card payments are available in the studio or online through your account or through PayPal using payments.casadance@gmail.com.

***Receive an 8% discount on your season tuition if paying by Cash or Check -Receive a 3% discount if paying by Credit/Debit

Gray Level Monthly Class Fees

Members Fee \$40.00 per student - Members Fee is non-refundable and ensures dancer's spot in class, discounted tuition rates, recital package rate, discounted dance wear, clothing, tights, shoes, costume prices.

Dancers receive 2 pair of Gray shorts, 1 pair of class tights, and one leotard upon payment of Members Fee and September's tuition. 2 tickets to the Holiday Christmas performances are included in your class fees.

Gray Level dancers pay \$175 per month for class fees September to June or may opt for Casa Stars and pay \$194 per month Sept-May (NO June payment)

Family Holiday Performances: Gray Level Dancers will be required to bring in paper snacks, desserts, or drinks. You will be assigned something to bring.

Awards Banquet: Gray Level Dancers will be required to bring in snacks desserts, or drinks. You will be assigned something to bring.

The monthly payment includes access to ALL Gray level class, required classes, and all Red and below level Technique classes. If a dancer is in a Red or Black Level class by Teacher Recommendation or is required to take additional classes, this monthly fee includes those classes.

Gray level dancers will be given payment options for Competitions and Costumes.

- Gray Level Dance Families will be given a fixed amount payment plan for costumes upon registration. Payment plans will be from September – January.
- You may choose at any time to pay off the full costume amount but must pay the payment plan until costumes are fully paid off.
- Gray Level Dancers will pay \$250 in January, February, & March towards competition. This includes Three group dances at three competitions & \$110 towards additional dances (solos or duets)
- You may choose to pay the entire competition amount at any time but unless payment is received prior to January the \$250 must be paid each month.
